The 33rd Annual Open Golf Tournament will be held April 25. Cost is \$125 per person and includes lunch, golf with cart, snacks, beverages, prizes and a reception. A vehicle lease is the hole-in-one prize. Prizes will also be awarded for closest to the pin and longest drive. Awards will be given for the top team in each flight.

"We are very pleased to host the golf tournament again this year," said Brenda Mayer, Indian Creek head golf professional. "Many of our Indian Creek members live at Rappahannock Westminster-Canterbury and others see it as their future residence as well. We are so lucky to have this top-notch retirement community right here in the Northern Neck, so we are happy to support their efforts in any way."

The tournament debuted before the first residents moved onto RWC's Irvington campus. The shotgun start begins at noon on April 25 and follows a Captain's Choice format. The rain date is April 27.
